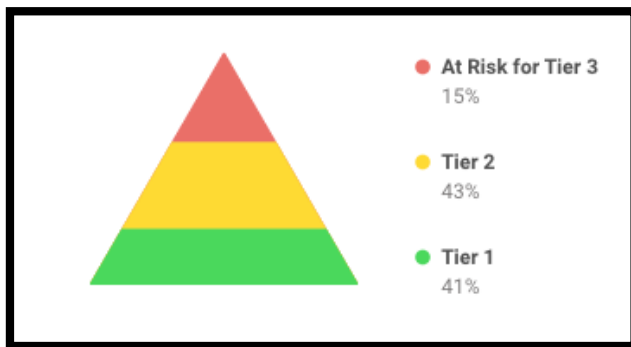

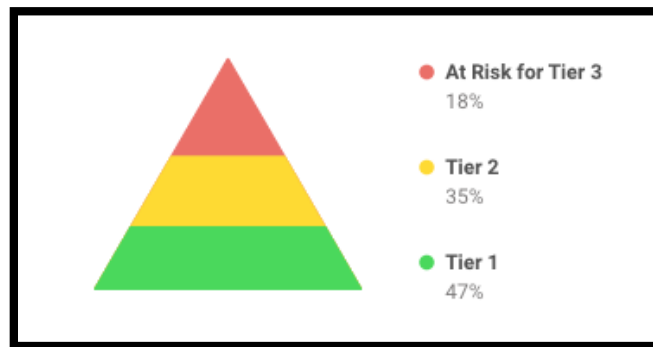

**HIGHLIGHTS**

- Panda Grant: Leader In Me (as of August 2020)
- John Marshall is the first GUSD school to receive PBIS Gold Award
- Schoolwide ELD/ALD designated time
- 15% of English Language Learner students were reclassified as Fluent English Speakers in 2019-2020
- From 18-19 to 19-20 school years, we have made 11% Growth in Student Sense of Safety based on Panorama Survey
- 80% of Marshall students feel connected and have a sense of belonging (9% increase from fall 2019) Marshall data shows 7% higher than GUSD average.

**BOLD STEPS**

- We will focus on strengthening Foundational Skills
- We will use Kagan Cooperative learning strategies to engage students in lessons and when Checking for Understanding
