All males 17-18 years of age: Under federal law, virtually all men must register with **Selective Service** within 30 days of their 18th birthday. However, the Selective Service System now accepts early submission of registration information by 17-year-old men. The Agency holds their registration information and automatically enters their data into the system when they turn 18. **If you don't register, you may not qualify for federal financial aid (FAFSA), Cal-Grants, job training, or State/Federal jobs.
