



Pink Panther Event and Field Trip Guidelines and Responsibilities



If funding is available and the Core’s academic and behavioral expectations have been met, we will have various on-campus Core events and possibly one off-campus field trip. Our Core events and field trips are an integral part of our curriculum and are specifically designed to match our content areas. We always hope that the vast majority of our students choose to participate in these events. All students are expected to meet the following guidelines in order to attend a field trip without a parent chaperone:

1. **Students may not be on behavioral probation.**
2. **Students may not have any referrals in their Core classes.**
3. **Students must demonstrate appropriate academic effort in all Core classes.**
4. **Students must practice acceptable behavior in all Core classes.**
5. **Students must have the approval of all Core class teachers.**

NOTE: If any students has not met the above guidelines, the Core teachers may choose to only allow the students to attend a field trip on the condition that the students are accompanied by their parent during the entire trip.

On-campus Core events and field trips are always planned on a school day and are, therefore, considered an academic requirement for students. The following will help clarify the assignments students will be expected to complete for any and all events.

1. Those students attending the field trip will have an assignment based on their experiences at the field trip location; that assignment will be due the next day after the completion of the field trip.
2. Those students not attending the field trip and coming to school on that day will have assignments equivalent in value to the field trip assignment. These assignments will be due the next day after the completion of the field trip day.
3. Those students not attending the field trip and choosing to stay home (with parental knowledge and permission) will have assignments equivalent in value to the field trip assignment. These assignments will be due the next day after the teachers assign them.
