In-School Fine Arts Program

Overview:

This 5-week developmentally appropriate, hands-on, cross-curricular visual arts program will cover multiple arts concepts through varied media, each week building upon skills and concepts learned.

Lessons customized for each grade-level at VW, with care taken to build students' artistic skills and understanding throughout their years in the program. Benefits include enhanced fine motor skills, knowledge of artists and art history, appreciation of art all around us and in our daily lives, and familiarity with tools and genres of art.

Instructor:

Brooke Sauer--- A Professional Teaching Artist with a BFA from Otis College of Art & Design and Masters from Art Center College of Design. For the past 14 years, Sauer has been teaching art to kids in various spaces such as J. Paul Getty Creative Core; LACMA; the Armory Center for the Arts; and Center for the Arts in Eagle Rock; and was the director of Echo Park's TIMBRE exhibition space. Sauer is affiliated with National Art Education Assn. and California Art Education Assn.

Schedule:

5 separate sessions, each consisting of (5) 45-minute workshops, which will serve all Kinder, 1st-, 2nd-, 5th- and 6th-grade classrooms.

Enrollment / Estimated Costs:

- Potentially serving (25) classrooms with no family supplemental contribution required.
- Costs include instructor and any necessary materials.
