In-School Fine Arts Program

Overview:

This 5-week visual arts program will cover multiple arts concepts through multiple media.

Instructor:

Brooke Sauer--- A Professional Teaching Artist with a BFA from Otis College of Art & Design and Masters from Art Center College of Design. For the past 14 years, Sauer has been teaching art to kids in various spaces such as J. Paul Getty Creative Core; LACMA; the Armory Center for the Arts; and Center for the Arts in Eagle Rock; and was the director of Echo Park's TIMBRE exhibition space. Sauer is affiliated with National Art Education Assn. and California Art Education Assn.

Schedule:

5 separate sessions, each consisting of (5) 45-minute workshops, which will serve approximately (25) $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ grade classrooms.

*Classes for Grades 1-2 would focus on Elements of Art, pairing 2 elements every week in a project, with the last week(s) devoted to a project that brings together all elements that we have investigated. We will use a variety of art media that is appropriate to the concepts. We will also reference contemporary and/or historical artists that will inspire our project.

Examples:

Week 1: Line & Shape project (paper collage/sculpture and/or printmaking)

Week 2: Color &
Value project (drawing & painting)

Week 3: Form & Texture project
(clay or multimedia sculpture)

Week 4 (& 5?) Final project

*Classes for Grades 3-6 would incorporate Elements of Art, but our focus will be on the more sophisticated Principles of art and would follow the same model above

Enrollment / Estimated Costs:

- Potentially serving (25) 1st 6th grade classrooms with no family supplemental contribution required.
- Costs include instructor and any necessary materials.
