SLAB ROLLER for Clay Projects

We are requesting funds from WAVE to purchase a clay slab roller which includes a 48" table and rollers.

Slab rollers create even and consistent slabs of clay very quickly for student art projects. Slab rollers can roll out large amounts of clay, which would normally be tedious and time consuming with a rolling pin, saving instructional minutes for the teachers and students.

All K – 6 teachers at VW would have access to using the slab roller for their students throughout the year.

We would like to purchase a trolley cart with wheels so that the slab roller can be mounted and be rolled around to various classrooms for different art projects throughout the year.

Additional slab mats are needed for white and red clay and to keep the clay fresh when mats get soaked from the rolling process. (at least 4 additional slab mats)

We have visited local GUSD school sites that have purchased and regularly use their slab rollers for school-wide use. We have heard consistent positive feedback from each school site.
