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By the end of the 6th grade year students need to be able to read and comprehend literature, including stories, dramas, and poems. Verdugo Woodland students will show that they have successfully met the English Language Arts Standards in a variety of ways which include, but are not limited to, citing textual evidence to support analysis of what the text says explicitly as well as inferences drawn from the text. Also, determining a theme of a text and how it is conveyed through particular details. In addition, showing how characters respond or change as the plot moves towards a resolution.

In addition to the reading common core standards, 6th grade math standards cover the following areas: connecting ratio and rate to whole number multiplication and division and using concepts of ratio and rate to solve problems; completing understanding of division of fractions and extending the notion of number to the system of rational numbers, which includes negative numbers; writing, interpreting, and using expressions and equations; and developing understanding of statistical thinking.

As you can see the range, quality and complexity of the 6th grade standards are quite impressive. Reading and Math Common Core is a great program that allows our students access to the various genres and standards needed to succeed. This is a program that is incredibly aligned with the standards and one that we believe directly benefits our students by increasing their reading comprehension, writing and math district scores as well as classroom grades.
