## General Announcements

- The library will be open at lunch starting this week. If you would like to go to the library during lunch, you must obtain a pass from your 4th period teacher. No students will be admitted to the library without a pass. No food or beverages are allowed in the library. The library is NOT open during snack.
- Students must return their books from the previous school year(s) and if so, pay the late fee. You may not get more books until you have returned all your books, but you may check out 1 library book for your English/reading class. Remember that your ASB card is also your library card and you should have it with you. Reminder: always have a book with you and read every day!
- Are you interested in learning about designing video games, animation, cinematography, or teaching young children? Free after school classes are available in these subjects at Glendale and Hoover high schools. The classes are open to all 6th, 7th, and 8th graders, and you earn middle school credit for completion.
