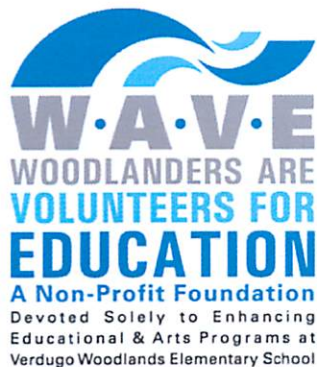

For the upcoming 2020-2021 academic school year, 6th grade teachers are requesting \$1500 to be used on a history, science or art field trip or school site visit presentation. These activities provide an engaging and interactive educational lesson-extension that correlate with the 6th grade level Common Core history, science and arts standards. Students will be given an out of classroom opportunity to integrate real-world connections with core content.
