

EDISON FIELD DAY

Edison Field Day Week is a 5 day long series of events that students and families can participate in through live Zoom meetings or on your own schedules. The first 4 days offer 3 live events at 10am, 12pm, and 2pm. On the last day there will be events at 10am and 12pm. Each of those events has a unique Zoom login code which will be available on our Edison School Website. Additionally, many teachers are also providing those links to their classes.

What do I need to do before I do an event either as a live Zoom or on my own schedule?

- 1- Watch the videos recorded by our teachers to see what the event looks like. There are event videos in English and Spanish for each event. Those videos are on our school website and some teachers might be sharing them with their classes as well.
- 2- Look at the equipment list on the school website or the teacher videos and gather your equipment for the events. REMEMBER that you always need a timer or someone to help you keep time and your score.
- 3- Print out the event scoresheets (English or Spanish) from the school website or from your teacher. If you prefer you can use any piece of paper to write your score on.
- 4- Figure out where you are going to do the event. It could be indoors or outdoors, but it needs to be a space where you can easily and safely move around.
- 5- Look at the event instruction cards in English or Spanish to help you understand how to do the event. Those are on the school website or your teacher may share them with you.

What do I do at the live Zoom event?

1. Login to your grade level Zoom event. The Zoom links are on the school website or your teachers may have sent them out as well.
2. Enter the Zoom meeting and follow the teacher's instructions.
3. The event itself will only take about 1 minute, but the live Zoom might be about 10 minutes.
4. You can try the event 3 times, writing your score down for each try.

What if I can't do the event during the live Zoom or if I have a problem with the live Zoom?

1. Don't worry, you can do the event anytime that day, but try to do it before 3pm.

What do I do after I have done the events for that day?

1. At the end of all 3 events each day login to your class's Google Classroom to report your best score for each event that day. This is optional, but we will be highlighting some of the results each day. **TURN YOUR SCORES IN BEFORE 4PM.**

What do I do after the last event on the last day?

1. Thank your family for helping you.

2. If you would like to make up your own event and record it in English or Spanish that would be awesome! Please only do this with your parents and only do this if you are willing to have others see your video. Parents can email it to Mr. Sondergaard at rsondergaard@gusd.net.
