Children may arrive at school **no earlier than 7:45 AM (M,T,W,F) and 8:45 AM on Thursday Banking days unless a child is participating in Extended Day Care or an otherwise supervised extracurricular activity.**

CLASSROOM DISRUPTIONS

Any interruption of classroom instruction has an impact on the learning process. Please have your child come to school well prepared and organized. Instructional time will not be disrupted in order to call students from class to pick up forgotten lunches, homework, projects, instruments, etc. Any items brought to the office will be placed on the counter for students to pick-up. Students must come to the office during recess and check to see if missing items have been dropped off. Students will **NOT** be called out of class. Parents may not disrupt instruction by entering a classroom during the instructional day to deliver any such items to your child.

CAFETERIA

Breakfast is \$1.25 for all grades. Children may bring lunch from home, or purchase one in the cafeteria for \$2.75 including a drink. Water may be purchased separately for \$1.00. Parents may prepay for breakfast, snack and lunch online at www.ezschoolday.com. You will need your student's ID#. Pre-payments may also be made in the cafeteria before school. Checks should be made payable to "GUSD". Increments of \$40.00 are recommended. Nutrition Services will notify you when the balance is low. Applications for the "Free and Reduced Lunch Program" are available online, in the cafeteria, and office. The menu is published each month and posted at the school and on the GUSD.net and www.VerdugoWoodlands.org websites. Copies can also be found in the display case across the office. On minimum days, students who purchase lunch will be served a sack lunch "to go." Please do **NOT** bring children lunches from local fast food restaurants in lieu of cafeteria food or a bag lunch. **Candy, gum, and sodas are not permitted.**

ABSENCES

Please call the school office or send a note with your child, giving the date and reason for every absence. You may also email your absence excuse to amgonzalez@gusd.net. **If your child has been ill with a communicable disease, or has had surgery, or is wearing a cast or splint, PARENT must bring their child – with a note from the doctor indicating clearance to return and listing restrictions - to the health office for clearance BEFORE the child can be readmitted to class.** If your child has been absent for 3 or more days, a doctor's note is required to return to school. Students with temperatures over 100 degrees must be kept home and must remain fever-free without medications for 24 hours before returning to school.
