PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITY:

I/We understand that by participating in my/our child's education I/we promote a positive attitude toward school and academic achievement. Therefore, I/we will:

- Provide a quiet study area where I/we can supervise the completion of my/our child's homework, monitor screen time, and extra curricular activities.
- Be sure my/our child arrives on time and is picked up on time.
- Understand that my child is attending Verdugo Woodlands and is expected to maintain good grades, have good behavior, and attendance. Excessive absences are defined as being equal to 10% of the school year or more. Three tardies in excess of 29 minutes will result in one unexcused absence (truancy).
- Provide a Doctor's note when my child has three consecutive days of absences, or misses a part of the day due to an appointment.
- For Independent Studies of 5-10 days, requests must be provided with at least two weeks' notice. (More than 10 days will result in students being dropped).
- Read school correspondence and sign documents when requested.
- Update Parent Portal as needed with Contact Information updates.
- Make an appointment to speak with the classroom teacher should any concerns arise or to schedule a classroom observation.
- Attend Back to School Night, Open House, and Parent-Teacher conferences.
- Support the school/district policies regarding carline procedures, homework, attendance, and school/classroom PBIS expectations - VW HOWLS!
- Participate in educational decisions through the School Site Council and coordinate volunteer opportunities in class and at school.
