GUSD Seeking Community Members for Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC)

Glendale, CA – Glendale Unified School District is currently soliciting applications to fill 5 (five) open seats on the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC). The Committee must have a minimum of seven (7) members appointed by the Board of Education of the Glendale Unified School District.

It is a two-year commitment. The Committee meets quarterly.

The CBOC was established in accordance with the strict accountability in Local School Construction Bond Act of 2000. The purpose of the Committee is to oversee the expenditures of bond proceeds generated from Measure S, the general obligation bond for school construction passed in April 2011 by the residents of Glendale Unified School District.

Expertise in areas such as architecture, engineering, construction, law, educational administration, financial management, real estate/development, construction management, and/or public administration is highly valued but is not required.
